Closing date for entries: Wednesday 20th October. **NO LATE ENTRIES.**

Entry Fees: As stated in each Section.

Tom Pearson Pavilion will be open for the receipt of exhibits on Thursday 21st October, from 12 noon to 5.00pm, Friday 22nd October from 9.00am to 2.00pm. Judging will commence in the afternoon, and no unauthorised persons will be admitted. Please assist by staging exhibits early, and by collecting prize money early on Show Day at Pavilion Office.

PLEASE NOTE: REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS – EXHIBITS CANNOT BE REMOVED BEFORE 5.00PM SATURDAY 23rd OCTOBER. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Exhibits may also be collected Sunday 24th October and Tuesday 26th October between 9.00am and 12 noon.

When entering exhibits, office will give you two numbered entry tickets. One to be sewn or attached to your exhibit, the other **MUST** be presented to claim **EXHIBIT**, and to claim **PRIZE MONEY**.

We suggest you write a description of exhibit on claim ticket, such as Sponge Cake, Toy, etc., this will help you and Steward when collecting exhibits.

All work must be bona fide work of Exhibitor.

Exhibits not to be shown more than two years.

Exhibits that have been washed will be disqualified.

Where only one entry in any class, to be left to Judge's discretion to award prize

TROPHIES won in Pavilion will be presented at 4.45pm. in Pavilion. Prize cards will be presented for 1st and 2nd Prizes and Highly Recommended.
