### **PEN OF 3 LAMBS SUITABLE LOCAL TRADE**

**CLASS 1** – Lightweight 15kg – 18kg

**CLASS 2** – Mediumweight 18.1kg – 22kg

**CLASS 3** – Heavyweight 22.1kg and over

1. Lambs to be penned on display by 9.00am Saturday morning, 23rd October. Hoggets included will disqualify any entry and will not be accepted.
2. Points lost for overweight and underweight lambs.
3. Lambs will be judged on hoof on Show Day, then on the hook at Goodchild Abattoirs, Australind, on Tuesday 26th October, after which prizes will be awarded at the luncheon on the Brunswick Showgrounds.
4. Weighbills must accompany each entry. On acceptance all lambs become the property of the Brunswick Agricultural Society (Inc.) as agents.
5. Points for each entry to be allotted at the discretion of the Judge as follows:
