**All entries to be removed at 5.00pm Saturday 23rd October. After 5.30pm no responsibility can be accepted for exhibits or containers.**

**OWNERSHIP OF EXHIBITS:** All exhibits to be grown by Exhibitor except Classes 55-84. Winners of Prize Money will greatly assist the Society by collecting same on Show Day at the Pavilion. In all decorated classes, grasses are not to be used for foliage unless stated. A vase must be greater in height than width.

A bowl must be equal to or greater in width than in height and the mouth at its shortest measure must be at least two-thirds of the width.

Exhibitors must supply their own flower containers.

Each specimen and cut to be in individual containers.
