CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All Exhibitors shall be bound to have read and accepted the "Conditions of Entry" and shall be bound by those conditions.
2. After the close of entries and until the awards have been made, no person shall be permitted access to the exhibits, excepting the Judges and Stewards.
3. One bottle (700ml or 750ml) per entry. Exhibitors may show more than one entry per Class providing that no two entries have the same main ingredient.
4. Wine labelled on arrival of entry.
5. Exhibits to be collected at 5.00pm on Saturday 23rd October.
6. Year of Vintage to be stated.
7. All entered wines will be judged on the following scale of points:
Colour and condition3 points
Bouquet7 points
Flavour10 points
8. The Judges and/or Chief Steward may disqualify an entry if it is considered to be falsely represented and/or may transfer an entry to another Class if it is considered to be wrongly entered.
9. Exhibitors shall be bound by the decision of the Judges and/or Chief Steward and no disputes will be entered into.
