HAND NEEDLEWORK

CLASS

1. Pre stamped embroidery article (tray cloth, table centre, runner or supper cloth)
2. Any article of embroidery. It can be old and laundered
3. Any article in Cross stitch on fabric (includes Cross stitch pictures worked on fabric, including Aida cloth but NOT canvas)
4. Any article in counted threadwork. May include satin stitch and Blackwork, but NOT cross stitch
5. Any article in Hardanger
6. **Embroidered cushion (filled) hand embroidered SPECIAL**
7. Any article in Crewel-work or wool embroidery

SECTION K – Hand Needlework: Machine & Stretch Knit Sewing

8. Needlepoint tapestry picture worked in wool and frame
9. Needlepoint tapestry picture worked in cotton thread and framed
10. Cross stitch picture worked on canvas and framed
11. Long stitch picture on canvas and framed
12. Any embroidered article by competitor over 65 years
13. Any article in hand made lace (bobbin, needle lace or knitted)
14. Any article in Tatting
15. Any article in raised embroidery. This may include Stumpwork, Brazilian and Elizabethan
16. Any article in Candlewicking
17. Any article in Ribbon embroidery
18. Any other type of modern contemporary needlework for which a class has not been provided.

NB: Any pictures must be properly backed and ready to hang.
