Doily, Table Centres, Duchess sets should be mounted on backing paper only, NO frames, leaving one corner unattached to allow for inspection of back of work. Tack half of exhibit to mount. There should be no loose ends. Limit of 2 items per person per entry. Knitting NOT to be attached to cardboard. Use safety pins only to attach cards, etc.

ENTRY FORMS MUST be lodged at the Secretary's Office by 7.30pm Wednesday the 20th October. **NO LATE ENTRIES.**

JUDGING POINTS ALLOCATION: First 5 points, Second 3 points.

ENTRY FEE: Class 1 \$2.50 All other Classes \$1.50

PRIZE MONEY: First \$10.00, Second \$7.00

SPECIAL CLASS 1: First \$50, Second \$25

Items may only be entered twice in consecutive years.

Society's entry card to be fixed to exhibit.

Tickets **MUST** be produced to collect exhibits and prize money.

CROCHET IN WOOL, COTTON OR SYNTHETIC CLASS

1. Crochet Rug - SPECIAL \$50, Second \$25
2. Ladies Shawl or Stole
3. Baby set
4. Item of Children's wear
5. Set of dolls clothing
6. Table centre or tray cloth, 35mm or over, to 50 denier
7. Doily, to 50 denier
8. Old crochet item above 50 denier (may have been laundered)
9. Three doilys or mats, each a distinctive type of crochet, to 50 denier
10. Duchess set
11. Cloth, 90cm or less
12. Article by competitor over 65 years
13. Any other item featuring crochet, not listed

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CLASSES 1, 22, 32: \$2.50 (all others \$1.50)

JUDGING POINTS ALLOCATION: First 5 points, Second 3 points.

ENTRY FEE: \$1.50 **PRIZE MONEY:** First \$10.00, Second \$7.00

CLASS 1: First \$50.00, Second \$25.00

Items may only be entered twice in consecutive years. Society's entry card to be fixed to exhibit. Tickets **MUST** be produced to collect exhibits and prize money.

HAND KNITTING IN WOOL, COTTON OR SYNTHETIC

Casting on and off of stitches to be done evenly in tension, not too tightly. Joining of yarn, picking up of stitches round neck and arm – bands to be neat. Evenness of fabric and tension – tension to be suited to yarn chosen. Suitability of yarn and colour as regards pattern chosen. Any appropriate seaming may be used. Buttons and ribbons must be sewn on in wool. No shank buttons to be used on baby garments.

14. Shawl, Pram or cot cover
15. Baby set
16. Child's Jumper
17. Child's Cardigan
18. Lady's or Gent's Jumper
19. Lady's or Gent's Cardigan
21. Article by competitor over 65 years
22. Any article featuring fancy textured yarn
23. Pair of Adult Socks
24. Filled Cushion Cover knitted both sides

MACHINE KNITTING

Exhibitors are restricted to one entry per Class. All work must be bona fide work of the Exhibitor. All entries **MUST** have been completed in the 12 months prior to the show. Hand spun wool **NOT** to be used in this Section. Sewing machine seaming is permitted but no over locking. Buttons must be sewn on using the same thread as garment, except where textured yarn has been used. 'Cut and Sew' is permitted **ONLY** on necklines.

CLASS

25. Baby set up to 18 months. Comprising of 2 pieces
26. Child's garment (up to chest 87cm)
27. Lady's summer top
28. Lady's Cardigan or Jumper
29. Any after five Garment (cut & sew permitted)
30. Man's Cardigan or Jumper or Vest
31. Any other **NON** wearable article (**NOT** toys)
32. Any other wearable Item / Not Listed
33. Any article featuring cross crafting (min 75% machine knitted)
