

# THE PRESIDENT'S TROPHY

---

## President: Mr. John Clark

1. The President's Trophy is offered for competition in Stud Cattle, Horses (breeding), Goats, Trade Cattle and Trade Lambs.
2. The Trophy will be awarded to the Exhibitor who accumulates the highest number of points in one, or a combination of the Section stated above.
3. The only Classes which will carry points in the respective sections are as under:

**Horses** – All Breeding Classes excluding Ridden and Group Classes

**Stud Cattle** – Single pen classes excluding type and utility, Special Classes, Group Classes, Special Awards and Special Prizes and the Beef Classic.

**Trade Cattle** – All Classes

**Trade Lamb** – Carcass on the Hoof

**Goats**– All Classes excluding progeny and Group Classes

**Exhibits receive points once only**

4. Points will be allotted as follows:  
FIRST, 4 POINTS; SECOND, 2 POINTS; THIRD, 1 POINT.
5. Points will not be allotted unless at least two Exhibitors participate in each Class, except in the event of the animal going on to win a Championship in competition in which case points will be awarded for the original Class in which the animal competed.
6. Exhibits entered must have been bred or produced by the Exhibitor or owned and domiciled at the Owner's property for a minimum of six months.

Excluding Trade Lamb Carcass.

## PEARSON PAVILION

The Society offers a trophy for competition in all sections of the Pavilion. The trophy will be awarded to the competitor gaining the highest overall points in the Pavillion. To be eligible they must have competed in more than one Section.

## RIDLEY PAVILION

The Society offers a Trophy to the Competitor gaining the highest overall points in Poultry and Pigeon Classes.
