Exhibits are judged on traits that contribute to carcase value and market suitability.

All cattle entered in the Hoof Competition will automatically be eligible for the Carcase Competition, allowing exhibitors to compare live animal assessment with objective carcase performance.

The competition promotes best-practice beef production and provides valuable feedback to producers on the performance of their cattle.

HOOF CLASSES

BA1 – Open Grainfed Yearling

Conditions:

- Pair of 0-4 Tooth Cattle
- 460–660kg liveweight
- Must be accompanied by MSA documentation
- NFAS documentation to accompany cattle where applicable

BA2 – Grassfed Yearling

Conditions:

- Pair of 0-2 Tooth Cattle
- 450–570kg liveweight
- Must be accompanied by MSA documentation

BA3 – Export Beef Animal

Conditions:

- Single exhibit
- Above 570kg
- Grainfed or Grassfed
- 0-4 tooth
- Must be accompanied by MSA documentation

Conditions of Entry

- All animals must be HGP-free.
- Correct breed details must be supplied on the NVD.
- A current and correctly completed National Vendor Declaration (C0720) must accompany all cattle and include Brunswick Agricultural Society PIC Number **WHS0019**.
- All cattle must be accompanied by MSA documentation (and NFAS documentation where applicable).
- All cattle must be NLIS tagged.
- Cattle will be mouthed to determine age eligibility.
- Exhibitors must have owned entered cattle for a minimum of six (6) months prior to the closing date of entries.
- Breed must be stated on the entry form.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to clearly identify entries to assist with drafting and penning.
- Cattle must be entered in the correct class.
- Brunswick Veterinary Services will be available if required.
- All cattle must be received by 8:00am and ready for judging by 9:30am on show day.
- All eligible cattle will automatically compete in the Carcase Competition.



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
