CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All animals to be HGP (Hormonal Growth Promotants) free
- Correct breeding supplied on NVD.
- Current NVD used correctly (Form C0720)
- All weaners weaned minimum ten (10) days
- Weaners must be owner bred
- Registered stock is not eligible
- Make entry for different classes easy to identify e.g. flag tags with numbers to help with drafting and penning
- Enter your cattle in the correct class
- Pair of weaned weaners to be same sex
- No entries will be changed on the day
- All cattle must be ear marked and NLIS tagged
- Cattle to be judged on: 1. Muscling. 2. Fat distribution. 3. Trade suitability.
4. Evenness of pen. 5. Fat content



Section BA - Quality Trade Cattle

- Cattle to be mouthed to determine age.
- Entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 6 months prior to the date of closing of entries and their breed must be stated on entry form.
- Levies and commissions will be deducted from sale proceeds.

Entry Fee: \$25 for all Classes BA1-BA5 will be deducted from proceeds.
