Rules and Conditions on Entry: *(Please read Entry Form carefully!)*

Entry Forms and Exhibits are to be left at the Secretary's Office **NO LATER** than **6pm Wednesday 21st of October** or by arrangement with Steward. **Late entries may miss judging!**

(We take **no responsibility** on late postal mail. Please advise us via email if you are posting photos.)

All Amateur Photographers are eligible and welcome to enter the competition providing they do not earn a majority of income through photography.

In every class the photographs **must** have been taken by the exhibitor. **NO PHOTOS** may be exhibited two years in a row or again if it/they have previously won prizes at the Brunswick Show as they will be disqualified!

ALL EXHIBITS: Must have: NAME of the Exhibitor, Section, Class, and Contact Phone Number on the **BACK of EVERY ENTRY!**

Children Exhibiting Must also include their Age along with above information when exhibiting in Classes P09 & P10. To ensure Exhibits are in the correct age class.

Classes PSF1 & P01 - P10: photos must only have **MINOR image manipulation** by a computer program. **No Filters** and **No Major Editing** to alter their original photos or to exclude or enhance parts of the original photos. The use of cropping, brightness, contrast and hue adjustments are permitted.

Failure to comply with Brunswick Show photography rules and conditions: Entries may be deemed ineligible for judging and **disqualified**. No refund of entry fees will be given if this occurs!

MOUNTING ALL PHOTOS: photos are to be mounted on black/white or light grey **THICK FIRM CARD**. (Mounting board, matting or 3mm Form Core is good. Try framers, art suppliers or Spotlight for this.)

NO CARDEX please (Cardex is NOT STIFF ENOUGH CARD to display photos!)

NO Plywood/hardwood/Masonite/**NO** coloured card/**NO** framed photos will be accepted.

FIRMLY ATTACH ALL PHOTOS to mounting boards, using **LOTS** of acid free **double-sided tape!!** (We take **NO** responsibility for photos that are damaged/fall off/or get lost if not adhered correctly.) Ensure Photos/Mount Sizing is **CORRECT SIZE** as disqualification **WILL** occur if incorrect.

Maximum of **THREE** entries per class is permitted per Exhibitor.

Minimum of **ONE** entries per class **required for Judging**

Collection of Exhibits:

Photography Entries **CANNOT** be collected before **5:00pm** Saturday 24th of October 2026.

Please note: should you require it, vehicles with a vehicle pass can access the Pavilion from 5:30pm via Gate 3 ONLY.

Exhibitors MUST bring their "Exhibitors card/s" to collect their photographs!

Exhibitors **MUST NOT REMOVE ANY PHOTOGRAPHS**. This is **STRICTLY** done by the Photography Steward and their assistants; they are the **ONLY** people to return photographs to Exhibitors.

Print/Mount Size: ALL PRINTS & MOUNT SIZES, PLEASE READ & CHECK SIZES of EXHIBITS BEFORE ENTERING:

(Any incorrect sized photographs **WILL** be Disqualified!)

- **P08 (ONLY)** - Minimum Photo Print size 10cm x 15cm or Maximum Photo Print size 13cm x 18cm. This is Per photograph with (3 or 4) photos required for a postcard display. (NOT 1 postcard photo with 3 or 4 smaller photos on it, this will be disqualified!). When displaying postcard photos allow small spacing around each of the 3 or 4 postcard size photos.
- **P09/ P10 (Additional Photo Print size for Students and Children CLASSES ONLY)** – Photo Print size 15cm x 20cm with a combine mount size Totalling 20cm x 30cm. P09 / P10 Can do bigger prints as below if want to.

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The **BELOW PRINT/MOUNT SIZES** are for **ALL CLASSES** (with exception of P08) -

Photos can also be any size "In Between" the min & max combine print/mount measurements but **MUST NOT EXCEED!**

- **Minimum Photo Print size** - A4 20cm x 30cm with a combine mount size Totalling 28cm x 38cm.
- **Maximum Photo Print size** - A3 30cm x 45cm with a combine mount size Totalling 40cm x 50cm.

Please DO NOT EXCEED THE ABOVE COMBINE PRINT/MOUNT SIZE MEASUREMENTS!

(Any incorrect sized photographs **WILL** be Disqualified!)
